

# Washington Comprehensive Assessment Program (WCAP)

## School Year 2009-2010

### **SUMMER 2009: WASL** (The "last WASL")

- This test administration is optional and is for students entering 11<sup>th</sup>- or 12<sup>th</sup>-grade who have yet to meet standard on the high school reading, math, or writing WASL tests.
- This test administration will be available only in paper/pencil format.
- This test administration will be held at Walla Walla High School for all district participating students.

Students entering grade 11 or 12	<b>M R W</b>	<b>Aug. 10<sup>th</sup>:</b> Reading, Sessions 1 & 2 <b>Aug. 11<sup>th</sup>:</b> Math, Sessions 1 & 2 <b>Aug. 12<sup>th</sup>:</b> Writing, Session 1- Expository <b>Aug. 13<sup>th</sup>:</b> Writing, Session 2- Persuasive	Approximately 90-120 minutes per test session. Morning sessions begin at 8:30; Afternoon sessions begin at 1:00

### **FALL 2009: DAW**

- This test administration is for 11<sup>th</sup>- and 12<sup>th</sup>-grade students receiving special education services who are taking the Developmentally Appropriate WASL.
- This test administration will be available only in paper/pencil format.

Students in grade 11 or 12	<b>M R W</b>	Monday, <b>Nov. 1<sup>st</sup></b> – Tuesday, <b>Nov. 9<sup>th</sup></b>	Approximately 60-90 minutes per test session

### **SPRING 2010: HIGH SCHOOL PROFICIENCY EXAM (HSPE)**

- This test administration is **required** for 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. It is also required for 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students who have yet to meet standard on the high school reading, math, or writing WASL tests.
- This test administration will be available only in paper/pencil format as no online testing is available for HSPE for the 2009-2010 school year.
- The number of testing sessions has been lowered by reducing the number of "extended response" questions on the reading, math, and science assessments.
- NOTE: Meeting standard on the state Reading and Writing tests is still a graduation requirement.

### SPRING 2010: MEASUREMENTS OF STUDENT PROGRESS (MSP)

- This test administration is **required** for 3<sup>rd</sup>- through 8<sup>th</sup>-grade students.
- OPSI will make the MSP available in two formats: (a) paper/pencil format; or (b) online format.
- As of this publication date, OSPI has not communicated the technology requirements for administering the online test. Thus, it has not yet been determined whether Spring 2010 MSP testing in Walla Walla Public Schools will be done in paper/pencil format or the online format.
- The number of testing sessions has been lowered by reducing the number of "extended response" questions on the reading, math, and science assessments.
- Note: The testing windows are different for the two available test formats.
