Dear Walla Walla Public Schools Parent/Guardian,

As the parent or guardian of a Walla Walla Public Schools student, we are pleased to share with you some information about a successful program we are continuing and expanding in the school district called *Online Grades*. Last year middle school and high school student's grades were available via *Online Grades*. Additionally, this year the district's elementary teachers will be participating in *Online Grades* beginning in December.

As the name *Online Grades* implies, student grades will be made accessible to parents and guardians via the internet. While a number of teachers in the district have provided parents with similar access in the past, the *Online Grades* program has some unique characteristics that are advantageous:

- ❑ "One-stop" grade checking – Parents with more than one student in a school, or parents who have students at elementary, middle, and/or high school will have a single access point to retrieve grades for all their students. The web address is <https://resources.wgps.org/onlinegrades/parents>
- ❑ Single log-in to retrieve grades from all your child's classes – Students may have five, six, or more classes. With *Online Grades* parents log-in just once and can check grades for all classes.
- ❑ Ease of use – The first time a parent registers in the *Online Grades* system and adds all their students to the account, the access to viewing a student's grades is truly just a mouse click away. A detailed help sheet designed to walk parents through the registration process in a simple, step-by-step fashion is available online and may be printed out: <https://resources.wgps.org/onlinegrades/ParentLoginforOnlineGrades.pdf>
- ❑ Convenience of creating your own log-in name and password – During the online registration process, parents determine a password and e-mail address to use for continued access to the *Online Grades* site.
- ❑ 24/7 access to the system – Because the system is online, you are able to log-in at your convenience, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

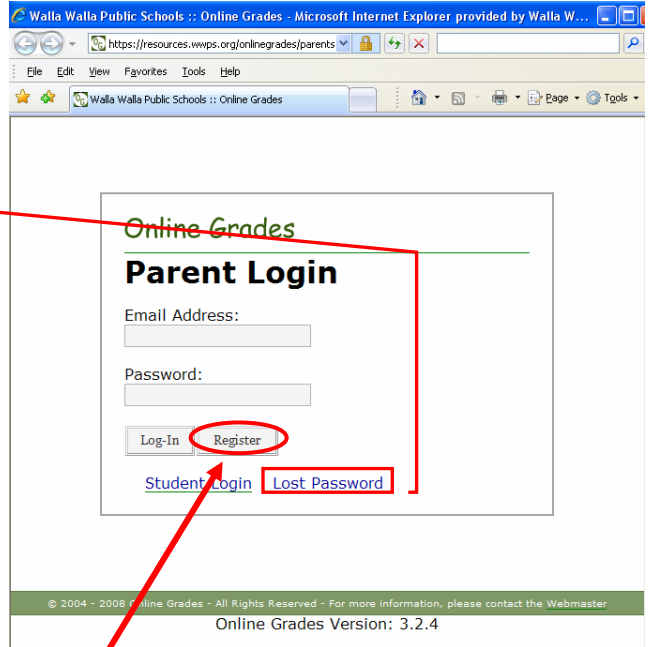

- ❑ Provides support for communicating with teachers – The *Online Grades* system places teacher e-mail contact information just a mouse click away. Parents are encouraged to have regular communication with teachers regarding their student's progress in classes.
- ❑ Detailed information about a student's grade – Parents get to know more than just a letter grade. Individual assignments that teachers place in their electronic grade book are displayed in *Online Grades*.

Here's what you will need to get started with Walla Walla Public Schools *Online Grades*:

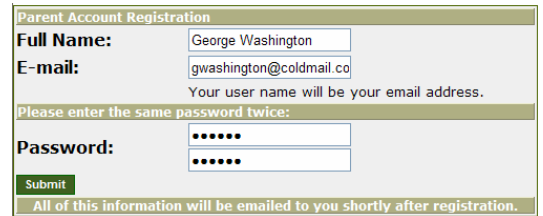
Did you access Online Grades last school year? If so, your log-in information has not changed and the web address is the same (<https://resources.wwps.org/onlinegrades/parents>).

- ❑ Students that you added to your *Online Grades* account last year are still attached to your account and if the student is in a new school, that information has been updated in the system. New children can be added to the system in the same way previous children were added (see step #6 below).
- ❑ If you've forgotten your log-in information, just use the "Lost Password" link on the *Online Grades* Parent Login webpage or contact us at onlinegrade@wwps.org

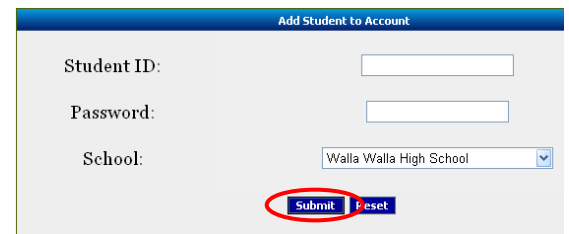
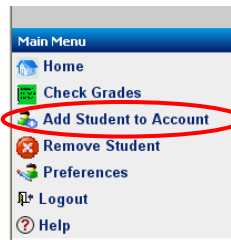


Are you new to Online Grades this school year? If so, then just follow these seven easy steps to set up your parent account and to attach your students to your account. (An even more detailed Parent Login Help Sheet is available directly as a PDF file at: <https://resources.wwps.org/onlinegrades/ParentLoginforOnlineGrades.pdf>)

1. Go to <https://resources.wwps.org/onlinegrades/parents>
2. Select and type in your **e-mail address** that you would like to use as your log-in name for *Online Grades*.
3. Select and type in your own password that you would like to use for *Online Grades*. (Note: This is a password of YOUR choice here; this is not your student's *Online Grades* password.)
4. Click on **Register** the first time you sign in to into the system.
5. Verify your full name, E-mail, and password. You will receive an automated e-mail confirmation shortly after registering the account. Now return to the website and select Log-In this time



6. You are then ready to "Add Student to Account" at which point you will need your student's *Online Grades* ID# and your student's password (see information below) and the name of the school they currently attend. Click "Submit" and repeat this process if you have more than one child in school.



7. That's it. Now select "Check Grades" from the Main Menu and you will have access to your student's *Online Grades*.

Required information about your student for registration: Information is available from your school or by e-mailing a request to onlinegrades@wwps.org (please include your name, you student's name, grade, school, and date of birth). Then write the information here and keep it in a safe, secure location.
