



Activity Cancellations due to Weather

SAFETY FIRST! Procedures for Afterschool and Weekend Activities

If school is canceled for the day

No activities, including games, practices, or community use events, will be held during normal school hours or afterschool when school is canceled for the day. Under rare conditions, such as a rapid improvement in weather, directors and/or principals may contact the Superintendent or their designee to discuss exceptions to participate in activities after normal school day hours. Community use decisions, under these unique rapid weather improvements, will be handled by the Director of Facilities & Operations.

Factors to be considered when determining whether or not to allow activities to be held after normal school hours, including games, practices, and community use events, include current and upcoming weather conditions, safe transportation by students, coaches, and spectators both to home and away sites, accessibility of buildings including sidewalks and parking lots, availability of officials and other game personnel and other safety issues and concerns.

If school is canceled for the day and the next day is Saturday

Athletic-related decisions will be handled by the Director of Athletics, in consultation with the Director of Facilities and Operations and Transportation Director. Non athletic-related activities and community use events will be handled by the Director of Facilities and Operations, in consultation with appropriate personnel.

Factors to consider include current and upcoming weather conditions, safe transportation by students, coaches, and spectators both to home and away sites, accessibility of buildings including sidewalks and parking lots, availability of officials and other game personnel and other safety issues and concerns.

If school is delayed for the day

If the district implements a two-hour delay, afterschool activities may be held, including games, practices, and community use, weather permitting. Factors to consider include current and upcoming weather conditions, safe transportation by students, coaches, and spectators both to home and away sites, accessibility of buildings including sidewalks and parking lots, availability of officials and other game personnel and other safety issues and concerns. Canceling of after school activities on delay days will be made by the Superintendent or their designee.

Media

If afterschool activities are canceled on a school day, the Communications Director will assist in releasing information to the media. If afterschool activities are canceled on a Saturday, break, or holiday, it is the responsibility of the appropriate director to inform stakeholders and media.
