Q. What are some of the jobs you do for the district?

A. I am one of two district carpenters. Together we build and repair various projects at all of the facilities across the district. This includes repairing and/or replacing doors and windows; designing and building cabinets, counters, cubbies, storage units; repairing bathroom stalls; and providing key and lock services.

Q. What do you enjoy most about this job?

Q. What are some of the recent projects you are most proud of?

Computer labs at most schools were retrofitted to better accommodate the needs of staff and students.
