



Wekiwa Tangelo

- * Wekiwa is a hybrid of grapefruit and Sampson tangelo and therefor should be called a tangelolo
- * It is delicious, very juicy, sweet and mildly acid
- * The tree is not vigorous but it is very productive and the fruit ripen in January.
- * Wekiwa is unlike any other tangelo because it looks like a mini grapefruit.
- * Under favorable conditions the rind is pink-blushed and flesh is amber-pink.
- * Also known as Pink tangelo and Lavender Gem
- * Wekiwa Tangelo first came from California in 1930 but was not introduced to the public in Florida until the 1980's
