## Behavior Specialist Supports

- Attendance at building team meetings discussing challenging behavior and systems of support. This may be your STATs, your Focus of Concern meetings, or Housekeeping meetings. Participate and support parent meetings.
- Functional Behavior Assessments at Tier 2 when necessary, and creation and support of Individualized Positive Behavior Support Plans.
- Facilitate Collaborative Problem Solving processes for identified students.
- Monitor, support collection, and analyze behavioral data.
- Assist teams in decisions to move forward with special education referrals or modify plans of support.
- Provide training on behavioral interventions to building level staff, based on identified needs.
- Point of contact for emergency situations.



## Mental Health Specialist

- Provide individual counsel to students presenting concerns as determined by the school team and District Behavior Intervention Team
- Attend building level meetings discussing students of concern.
- Coordinate school and community resources to support student mental health.
- Provide staff training on mental health and it's impact on student behavior.
- Provide opportunities for staff self-care sessions and support.

## Intervention/Behavior Coaches

- Ensure fidelity of implementation for individualized behavior support plans.
- Model and coach staff to implement plans.
- Analyze data to support creation and adjustment of function based support plans.
- Support student plans by creating behavior support tools.
