What is Title 1 & Family Engagement?



Title 1 provides extra educational assistance beyond the regular classroom instruction. Title 1 schools in our district are school-wide programs meaning funds are used to support all students.



Title 1 is a federally funded program used to help students reach achievement goals. It is determined by free or reduced lunch numbers in a school.



Title 1 provides supplemental support through staffing, learning materials, supplies and professional development.

Title 1 funds are reserved for family engagement at each school. Families have input on how family engagement money is spent each year based on <u>SURVEY</u> results and annual meeting outcomes.





Title 1 also requires that a SCHOOL COMPACT is developed by staff and families to address how schools will: communicate with families, provide decision making opportunities, and encourage partnerships. Title 1 requires that a FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PLAN is developed jointly with staff and families to address ways families can be involved and collaborate with schools to improve student academic achievement.
