Community Facilities Task Force releases survey to test needs priorities

WALLA WALLA – Following 13 months of study and extensive research, the eighteen-member Community Facilities Task Force is seeking a second round of public input on its work to date. Based on staff and community survey engagements last spring, in addition to comprehensive facility analysis performed, the committee is recommending practical renovations of Walla Walla High School, Lincoln High School, and Pioneer Middle School. Other facility needs across the district like roofing, heating and cooling systems and life safety have also been identified as priority projects. The district is eyeing November 2018 as a potential date for a bond issue and has declared this school year as one dedicated to community input and engagement.

Step one of this year's input process begins with a survey testing the facilities improvement priorities established by the Community Facilities Task Force. Information gathered from this survey will help shape bond package options the Community Facilities Task Force will present to the school board in December. The school board will then seek further community input on these potential bond packages following winter break before making a final decision in May on a November 2018 bond proposal.

Please take a few minutes to complete this survey and share your thoughts. The survey remains open through Oct. 11. Hard copies of the survey are available by request at the district office. Participants may wish to preview the draft concepts first prior to completing the survey.
