✦ **Free screening** to identify children and youth ages 0-21 with delays or disabilities who may need early intervention or special education services.



Disability areas may include . . .

- ◆ **Autism**
- ◆ **Emotional/behavioral disabilities**
- ◆ **Hearing impairments/deafness**
- ◆ **Intellectual disabilities**
- ◆ **Learning disabilities**
- ◆ **Any condition that affects a child's ability to learn**
- ◆ **Multiple disabilities**
- ◆ **Orthopedic impairments**
- ◆ **Speech or language impairments**
- ◆ **Traumatic brain injuries**
- ◆ **Visual impairments/blindness**
