



# Wekiwa Tangelo

- \* Wekiwa is a hybrid of grapefruit and Sampson tangelo and therefore should be called a tangelolo
- \* It is delicious, very juicy, sweet and mildly acid
- \* The tree is not vigorous but it is very productive and the fruit ripen in January.
- \* Wekiwa is unlike any other tangelo because it looks like a mini grapefruit.
- \* Under favorable conditions the rind is pink-blushed and flesh is amber-pink.
- \* Also known as Pink tangelo and Lavender Gem
- \* Wekiwa Tangelo first came from California in 1930 but was not introduced to the public in Florida until the 1980's
