Support for School Facilities Replacement Bond

WHEREAS, the voters of Walla Walla School District are being asked to vote upon Proposition No. 1: Walla Walla School District 140 Replacement Bonds to Renovate, Improve and Preserve School Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the renovation and improvement of Walla Walla High School, Lincoln High School, Pioneer Middle School and other school facilities is the preeminent building priority, as established by the Community Facilities Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the bond carefully manages our community's resources by preserving its substantial investment in our existing school facilities, maintaining the current bond tax rate per thousand dollars of assessed valuation, and investing all state match dollars on the projects that generate them; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Walla Walla School District 140 considers it a priority to notify the taxpayers within the school district's boundaries of its position on this bond issue.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the board expresses its support for Proposition No. 1: Walla Walla School District 140 Replacement Bonds to Renovate, Improve and Preserve School Facilities and its encouragement for individuals to vote on November 6, 2018.
